New Fire Dept. pickup truck is in service.

Call Force – One more member was just hired who has experience.

Run report - 81 runs for October, including 64 EMS calls, of which 10 were transports.

<u>Erving fire</u> – We sent help through mutual aid to fire in Erving, which claimed a child's life. A couple of our guys went to debriefing to deal with the loss.

Old Deputy's car - The 2007 Ford Taurus is off the road. Motion was made by Dave to declare it surplus and Jay seconded. All in favor. John will put it out to bid.

Regionalization study grant through the Council of Governments did not go through.

<u>Fire Academy</u> – Two new firefighters graduated from the academy. Walker was top student in the class.

Free Cash information has been submitted.

<u>Tax Collector's salary</u> – Prudential Committee decided to keep the District's salary to the Town's salary percentage for the new collector the same as the previous collector's. This figures is 81.65% of the FY17 budgeted amount.

Ladder truck – A committee is starting to look at what we will need.
