In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Turners Falls Fire District who are legally qualified to vote in said District Meeting, to assemble in the cafeteria at the Franklin County Technical School, located at 82 Industrial Blvd, Turners Falls, on Tuesday, May 20, 2025, at 7:00 P.M., then and there to conduct the following business:

ARTICLE 1. To determine if the District will vote to receive the reports of the District Officers as published, and further vote to hear and accept the reports of any committee appointed by the Moderator, and take any relative action thereon, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 2. To determine if the District will vote to authorize its Treasurer, with the approval of the Prudential Committee, to borrow money from time to time in anticipation of revenue or water rates for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 4, and issue a note or notes thereof, payable within one (1) year, and renew any note or notes as may be given for a period of less than one (1) year, in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 44, Section 17, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 3. To determine if the District will vote to require a bond from a fidelity company for its Treasurer, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 4. To determine if the District will vote to authorize the Prudential Committee and/or the Water Commissioners to apply for and accept grants from the Federal Government, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, or any other source, and to expend the same for purposes received without further appropriation, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 5. To determine if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026, for the purpose of **operating said District**, in accordance with the amounts requested and proposed in the Annual Report for such operational purposes, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for the **Salaries and Benefits of 3 Additional Firefighters**, including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

Amount Requested.....\$ 240,000

ARTICLE 7. To determine if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to **purchase a Command Vehicle for the Fire Department**, including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

Amount Requested.....\$ 85,000

ARTICLE 8. To determine if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to purchase a compressed air filling station for the Fire Department, including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

Amount Requested.....\$ 90,000

ARTICLE 9. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for the **Stabilization Fund for the future purchase of vehicles for the Fire Department**, or take any action relative thereto.

Amount Requested......\$ 300,000

ARTICLE 10. To determine if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to **update Alarm**System at the District Office and Water Facilities, including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

Amount Requested.....\$ 40,000

ARTICLE 11. To determine if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to **Pave and Line Stripe the District Office Parking Lot**, including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

Amount Requested.....\$ 70,000

ARTICLE 12. To determine if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to **inspect and clean the storage tank**, including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

Amount Requested.....\$ 5,000

ARTICLE 13. To determine if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow, or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to **supplement the funding for the Ambulance purchase**, originally authorized by the vote take under Article 5 of the 6/16/2020 Annual District Meeting and additionally funded by a USDA grant, including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 14. To determine if the District will vote, in accordance with the provisions of G.L. c. 44, §53E1/2, and authorized by Chapter 170, Section 1 of the Acts of 2015, to establish the spending limit for the revolving fund for Land Management for Fiscal Year 2026 at \$29,224, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 15. To determine if the District will vote to authorize the Board of Assessors to use any sum or sums of money from available unappropriated funds for the purpose of reducing District Taxes for the fiscal year July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, or take any action relative thereto.
